A Lecture on the History and Future of the Two States Solution Held at An-Najah:

Leadership Training Institute 2009 continued its activities this summer with a lecture held at Zafer Al-Masri Auditoriums at An-Najah National University's Old Campus. The lecture titled, "From Oslo to Cairo, the History and Future of the Two States Solution" was given by Mr. Saed Abu Hijleh, the Academic Advisor of the LTI, and the Lecturer at the Department of Geography at An-Najah National University.

The speaker went through the different phases of establishing the state, classical requirements of the state, such as: land and water territory, permanent resident population, government, organized economy, sovereignty, etc... and the process of Palestinian state formation. Mr. Saed also talked about the issues of peace process, Israeli occupation, the apartheid wall and the ethnic cleansing of Palestine in 1948 reaching back in time to the history of Palestine.
